Rizwana belongs to a very poor family. Her husband is a rickshaw puller. She has two children. The financial condition of the family has been very poor. Rizwana

always wanted to learn cutting & tailoring but due to her poor financial condition she was not able to take admission in any institute.

When Bal Sahyog started survey for identifying the poor and deserving candidates for the cutting and tailoring batch of 2014-2015, we came across Rizwana. Looking towards her interest and poor financial condition we motivated her to take admission in



our cutting & tailoring center. She took admission in the cutting & tailoring course and worked with dedication and interest in the lessons. During her course she made dresses very neatly and also completed her file of samples and theory of cutting and tailoring successfully.

During her course she started earning and working with people in her neighborhood. She started taking work from tailors like stitching of suits, blouse, turpai etc. After completion of six months course of cutting & Tailoring she started earning Rs.4000/- to 5000/- per month and able to help her family financially. Now she wants to open her small boutique in Wazirpur.
